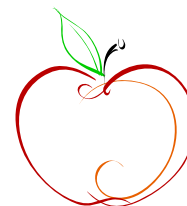


Adult Training Opportunities Seats Still Available in 2009 - Register Now!



Are you still looking for an adult training to meet your requirements for Troop Leadership, SU positions or just want to enrich your knowledge? Check out these trainings that are now available in your area.

TROOP LEADERSHIP TRAININGS

Basic Leadership Training - Brand new adult volunteers must complete this course to be appointed to the leader or co-leader of a troop. This course provides initial information on getting the troop started, troop meetings, working with the girls, and safety procedures to help the volunteer obtain the necessary skills to have a successful troop. For course completion, participants must contact the local service unit to receive the "way of work" presentation.
