We have 2 exciting trips planned for 2011!



Savannah, Georgia – Juliette Gordon Low’s Birthplace (pictured top left); June 18-25, 2011 for 2nd year Juniors, Cadettes, Seniors & Ambassadors. Troops only with a 1 adult:3 girl ratio.

- Journey to the place where Girl Scouting began! Discover Savannah via trolley, visit Paula Deen’s restaurant, enjoy a river boat cruise, spend a night at the theater, visit Old Fort Jackson and Tybee Island, and more!
- All travelers will participate in a Heritage Visit at the Birthplace and Girl Scout Seniors and Ambassadors may choose to participate in a special program featuring a Southern meal highlighting 19th-century dining customs. While in costume, girls set a formal table, serve the meal, clean up afterwards and may play Victorian parlor games.

London, England - Pax Lodge World Center (pictured top right); session July 2011 (exact dates TBD) for girls 15 and older; 14 with travel experience; Girls only – they will travel with Adult Coordinators.
