Do you want to travel?

A *destination* is your chance to go somewhere new, do something different and meet people from everywhere you can imagine! A *destination* is any experience, regardless of distance or length of time, which provides a girl 11-18 with an opportunity to expand her personal experience beyond her everyday scope. Events typically range in length from 2-10 days. There's something for everyone – you may choose to write and direct your own film, climb mountains or dive underseas, work with girls with disabilities or protect fragile ecosystems. Some destinations sites include Hollywood, Alaska, San Diego, Nevada, Yosemite National Park, Peru, Ireland and more!

Orientation is not required, but helpful! Past participants share their stories and trip experiences, and volunteers give application tips and answer your questions.

Girls traveling on *destinations* are eligible to receive a scholarship from San Jacinto Council to assist with the cost of the *destination*. In order to qualify as a recipient, you must participate in the 2010-2011 Girl Scout Cookie Sale and Fall Product Sale. So if you're considering *destinations*, be proactive and participate in both sales!
